Dear 4-H Members, Adult Volunteers, Families, and Friends:

**RE: Reopening 4-H in Nova Scotia – Phase One**

4-H Nova Scotia would like to thank those who completed the online questionnaire regarding comfort levels with a return to in-person 4-H programming.

Although adults reported a significantly higher comfort level, our members are still holding reservations with returning to in-person meetings and activities. Based on this information, 4-H Nova Scotia, like other organizations, will be implementing a phased reopening guided by Public Health Guidelines, the needs of the 4-H community, and common sense.

We understand that re-entry during a pandemic will be uncharted territory, however, participant safety is our primary focus. 4-H Nova Scotia will be here to support leaders, members, families, and volunteers through this process with a clearly laid out five-phase reopening plan complete with resources for use by the 4-H community.

At this time, the Board of Directors has approved phase one and are finalizing the resource materials to accompany it. **The full reopening framework will be available on the 4-H Nova Scotia website and via email on September 4, 2020:**

- Phase One will take effect on September 4, 2020
- Phases Two through Five will be announced as they take effect in accordance with Public Health guidelines and as comfort levels of the 4-H community increase.

We ask that members, leaders, volunteers, and families become familiar with the resource materials and requirements for reopening that can be found on our website by end of day on September 4, 2020.

There will be online questionnaires for families to complete throughout this process in order to gauge our 4-H community needs, so we ask that you take the time to complete them and let us hear your voice.
