

4-H Weekend

4-H Weekend is a great opportunity for families to socialize and participate in a variety of events, including a dance, communications and woodsmen competitions. The weekend culminates with 4-H Night in Nova Scotia, a celebration of achievements and 4-H spirit.

- ❖ One (1) adult chaperone will be assigned to every ten (10) members. All adult chaperones must have completed 4-H NS screening.
- ❖ Cloverbuds may attend the event but must be accompanied by, and room with, a parent. Cloverbuds will be the responsibility of the parent and will not be assigned to a chaperone.
- ❖ Accommodation will be made to ensure that Chaperones are residing near the group that they are traveling with.
- ❖ Registration fee per applicant is **\$40. Fees must be paid to 4-H Nova Scotia prior to checking in for the weekend.** (Please Note: Some counties may collect registration fees from their members, and then write 4-H Nova Scotia a county cheque; please check with your county for procedure). Please note on the cheque what the payment is for 'i.e., 4-H Weekend for John Doe'
- ❖ Registration fee covers meals and accommodations. Delegates are encouraged to participate in all events and meals throughout the weekend.
- ❖ 4-H'ers are discouraged from bringing valuables or electronic equipment to 4-H Weekend.
- ❖ Volunteer chaperones will be expected to contribute to chaperone duty in residence throughout the weekend and will have the opportunity to identify a preferred time on their application.
- ❖ All those staying in residence during 4-H Weekend will be required to attend a floor meeting to go over responsibilities and behavior expectations.
- ❖ **Important:** All vehicles parking on campus require a Dalhousie parking pass. Please indicate on your member's application form if you will require a parking pass so that we can ensure one is available for you at check-in.

At all 4-H Nova Scotia Events, all those attending are expected to abide by **4-H Nova Scotia's Code of Conduct. Those who are found in violation of the Code of Conduct, may be excused from 4-H Weekend..**

Counties are encouraged to hold a county meeting, with 4-H Weekend participants, prior to the event, to ensure that all are aware of Code of Conduct and expectations.
