

Camp Rankin County Scholarship



In Recognition of 48 years of Camp Rankin

A scholarship is available for one Junior 4-H member (9-12 years) *OR* one Intermediate member (13-15 years) per county to attend Camp Rankin in the summer of 2020.

4-H Nova Scotia will pay the total cost of registration for the camper.

Selection for the awards must take place in time to ensure the member has submitted a completed Camp Rankin application. This application must be received by the 4-H Nova Scotia Office by April 28th, of the current 4-H year, clearly marked as the county scholarship.

Selection requirements are up to individual counties. Suggestions include, but are not limited to:

- A draw of all members who have done a demo or speech at the club level, or at the county level.
- The member who has improved the most.
- Based on financial need.
- Any other criteria determined by the county.

This process will be evaluated at the end of the summer and counties are asked to let 4-H Nova Scotia know the criteria they used and their evaluation of the initiative.
