Agriculture and 4-H Scholarship

Scholarship Donor

Nova Scotia Department of Agriculture, to recognize the development of young people, offers up to four (4) \$1,000.00, scholarships. Scholarships will be presented to students enrolling in their first-year program in Agriculture, Veterinary Science, or disciplines related to an agriculture related career.

Who is Eligible?

Rural youth and 4-H members or former 4-H members who are in Grade 12, who will be entering a Bachelor Program at a recognized university that will lead to a further career related to agriculture.

How Do You Apply?

All applicants must complete an information sheet on their 4-H background, write an essay of 1,500 words on the topic, "*Agriculture's Importance to Rural Communities*," submit a letter of recommendation from a community leader and transcript of their current marks.

Successful applicants will be judged by a panel of judges. Scoring system is as follows:

- 50% on the essay, 30% on the completed application and 20% on the transcript of marks

Information for Applicants

Essays must be typed or neatly handwritten.

All essays, transcripts of marks and application forms must be received by **April 1, 2019** and sent to the attention of:
