

WOOL COMPETITION (class #68)

Open Competition



1. **Open to all 4-H members to participate in regardless of projects enrolled in.**
2. The top two junior and the top two senior Wool Competition articles per county from ANY project are eligible to move on to 4-H Nova Scotia Provincial Show.
3. Articles must be made from a minimum of 100% wool. Members competing in this competition must complete the attached **Wool Competition/Explanation Sheet**.
4. A completed report/explanation sheet for the article must accompany it at ALL levels of competition.
5. It is recommended that the judges of this competition evaluate the items according to the following guidelines:

25% - written explanation

75% - finished project

ALL 4-H members enrolled in a project ARE ELIGIBLE for this competition. Members enrolled in the crafts, heritage, sewing and environment projects can use their Wool Competition item as credit towards their project achievement day completion.

Members may exhibit/enter their wool article in either the Wool Competition or in the appropriate section of their Project Class, but not in both competitions. Prizes will be awarded to the top junior and top senior wool articles at the 4-H Nova Scotia Provincial Show. At county competition, this is a ribbon class only.
