NOTES: A dog which would have failed a principal feature of any exercise, had the handler not given an extra command, will be scored as having failed the exercise and is not to be confused with extra encouragement. The judge's decision is final.  Each exercise shall be scored by the point system in place under CKC rules. However, the judge will score 75% of the total marks on the basis of the handler's performance, and 25% of the total marks of the performance on					
the dog/handler team. Scores shall be awarded on the basis of the handler's performance.  The 4-H Pre-Novice level has the same requirements according to CKC rules with the exception of <b>off leash</b> changed to <b>on leash</b> at the 4-H Pre-Novice level.
