Activity #1: Before you Start

This activity can be completed as a large group or in smaller groups. Before we start any project or craft it's important that we have thought through the process and are prepared. Present scenarios to members and have them brainstorm how they would prepare the project ahead of them.

Here are some examples of scenarios:

- You are making a piece of clothing for a family member
- You are making a shelf for your entrance way
- You are making a baby blanket
- You are taking photos at a family event

Activity #2: Design a pattern/ game

Challenge members to come up with their own pattern for a fabric, scrapbooking paper, digital screensaver, poster, game, step by step guide. Members can design their pattern by using traditional paper and coloured pencils or get technical and use a software like Canva to create their pattern. Encourage members to experiment with colour, materials and thinking outside the box to create their pattern/article/game.
